The Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR)

The Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) is an international standard for describing language ability.

It is used around the world to describe learners' language skills.

Level	Level Name	Description
A1	Beginner	Can communicate in basic English with help from the listener
A2	Elementary	Can communicate in English within a limited range of contexts
B1	Intermediate	Can communicate essential points and ideas in familiar contexts
B2	Upper Intermediate	Can use English effectively, with some fluency, in a range of contexts
C1	Advanced	Able to use English fluently and flexibly in a wide range of contexts
C2	Proficiency	Highly proficient- can use English very fluently, precisely and sensitively in most contexts
